Questions Addressed

- What do I do if I am having trouble connecting with SSHFS? What do I do if I am having trouble connecting with SSHFS?
- If it keeps asking you for a password, then first connect via SSH in Terminal. Once you have successfully logged into that system, logout and try s shfs again.
- If when connecting with SSH and you get an error message that looks like the following:
